




The Multiple Angle Deadrise Hull (MAD-H) is comprised of a series of steps of decreasing deadrise (the angle of Vee a hull has relative to the horizontal surface of water.) The steeply angled keel step cleanly parts seas. Secondary steps compress air producing an air-cushioned ride for extra smooth cruising. Decreased deadrise at the chine has a trim-tab effect promoting quick planing and reduced friction — the result, less wetted surface using less horsepower!

From stern to bow, SEAWOLF's MAD-H design delivers performance, comfort and stability unmatched by standard Vee hulls.

Engineered excellence best describes the construction of this deflective-proof, rigid, two-piece hull and deck design. The stringer system is actually part of the deck. This integral fiberglass box stringer system is filled with foam flotation and bonded to the hull. Unlike conventional three-piece hull, deck and stringer systems, the SEAWOLF's unique two-piece construction provides for unsurpassed strength, insuring years of offshore action.
